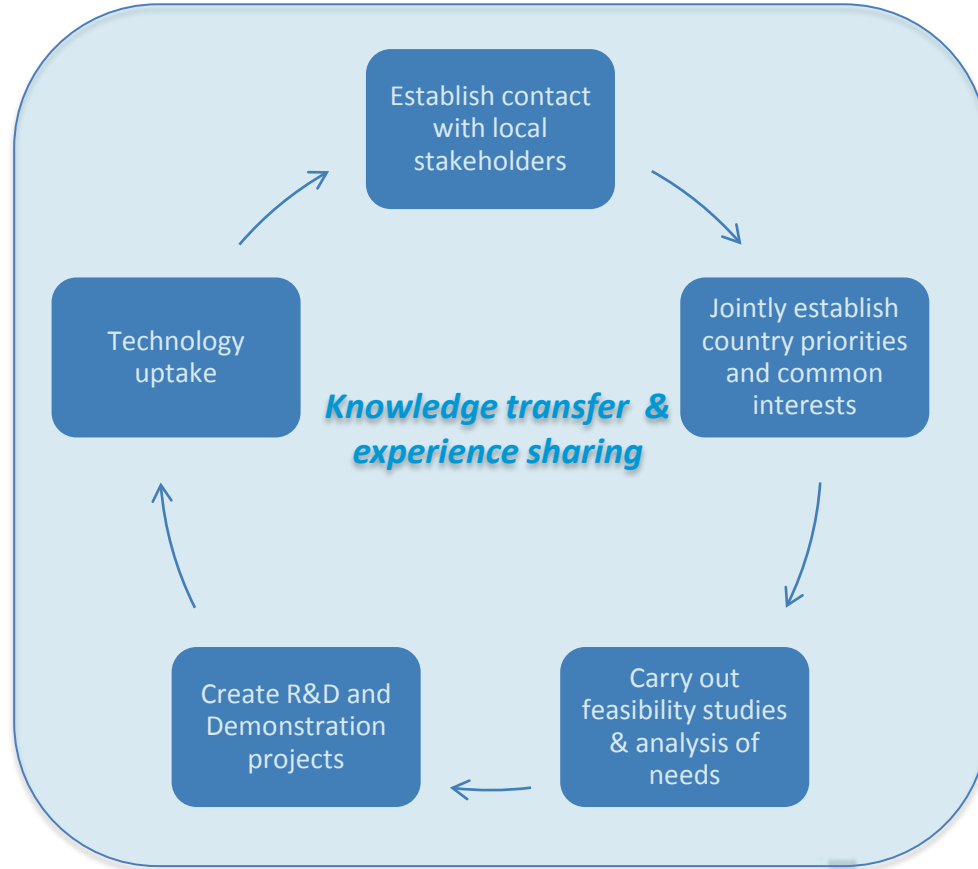

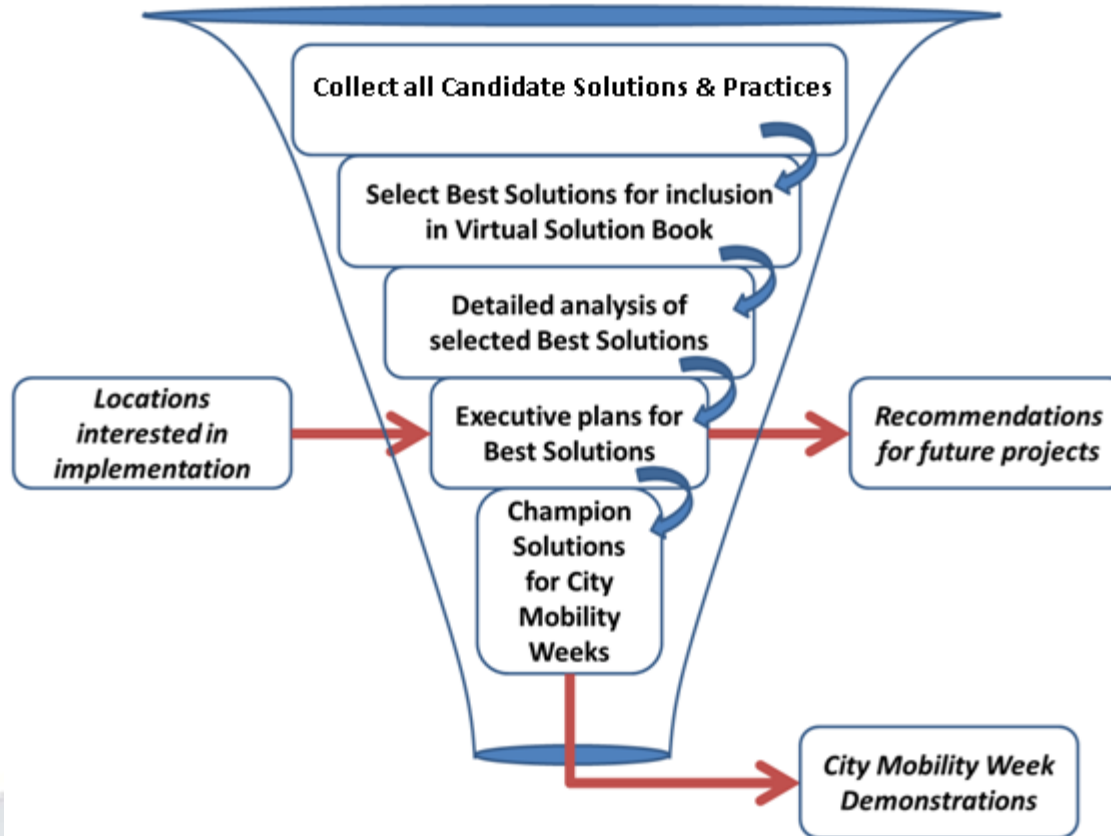


# Key Activities

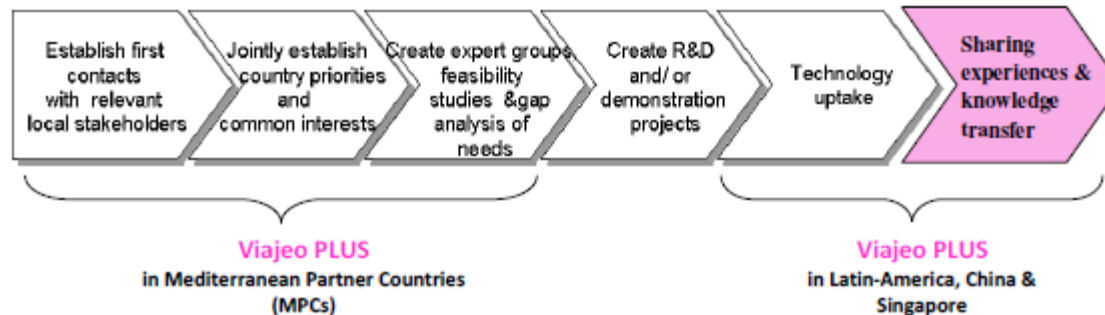

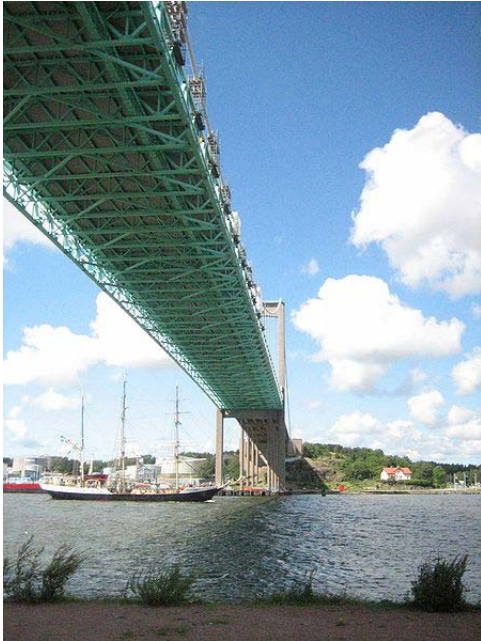
